Methodology


Number of respondents: 105 Dickinson students

Margin of error: 9.56

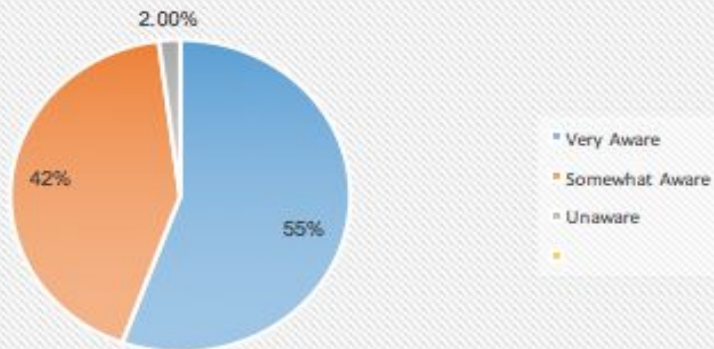
Dates of survey responses: March 30, 2017- April 11, 2017

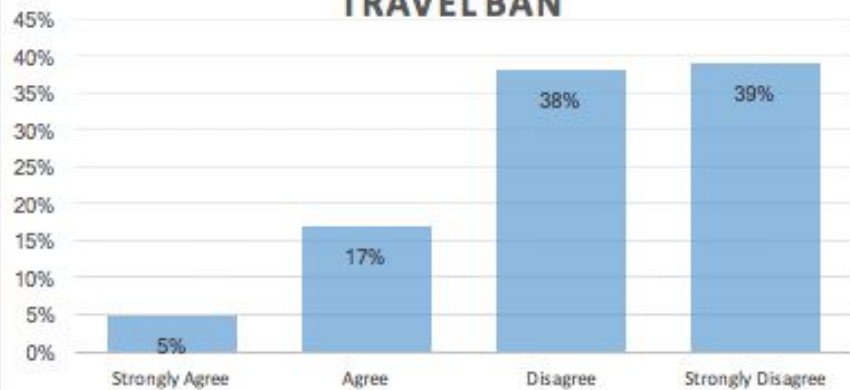
The survey was also posted in the Dickinson Class of 2018 Facebook group, as well as sent out in the Dickinson Men's Lacrosse email chain.



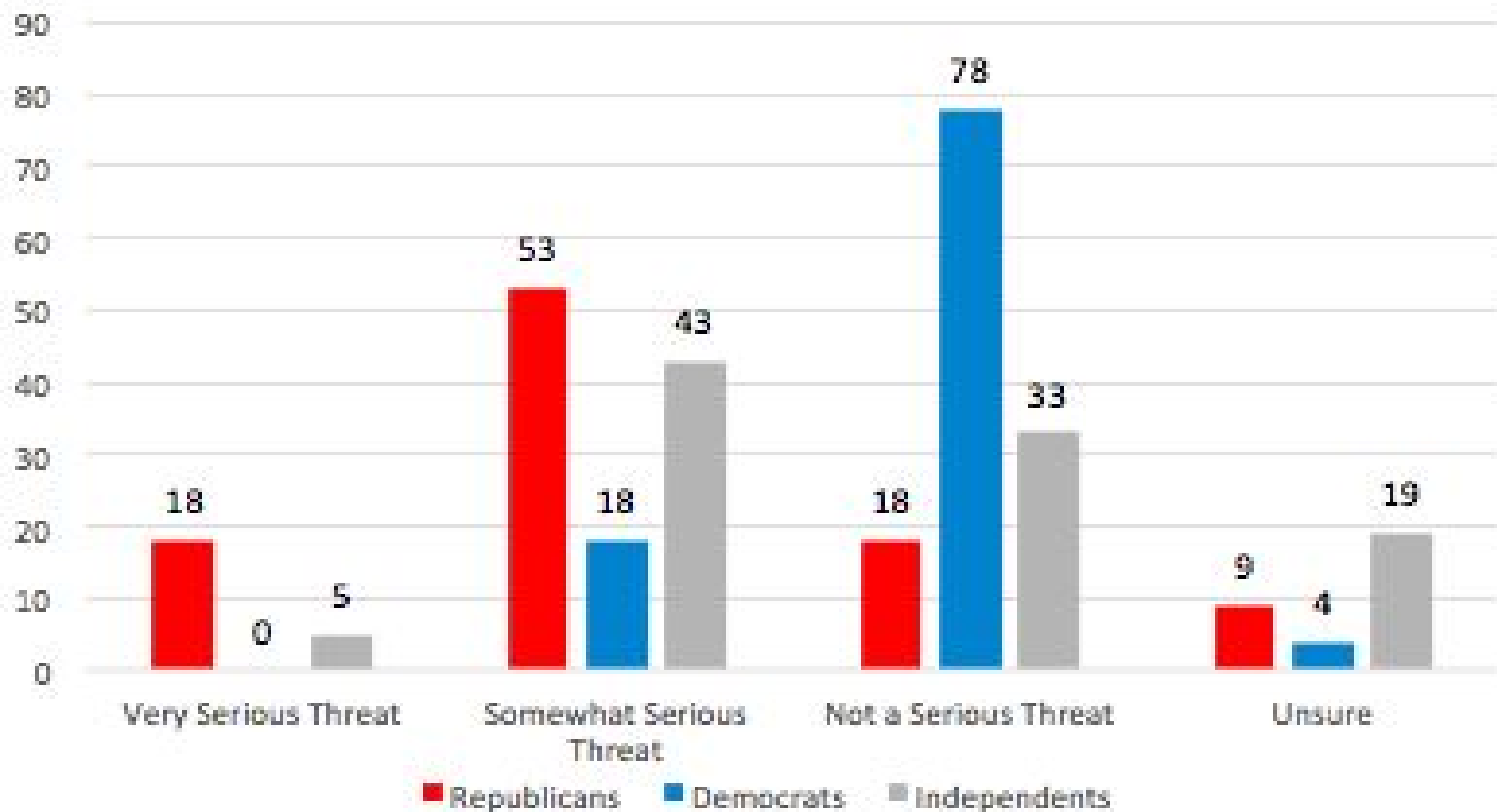
Awareness of Trump's Executive Order Travel Ban

Threat Level of potential Terrorist Threats

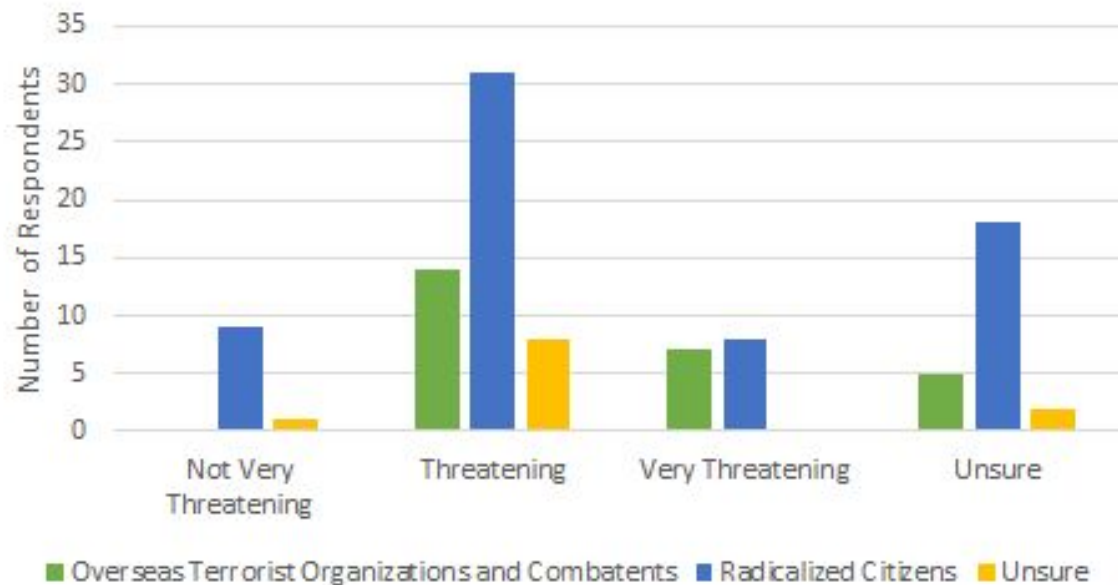
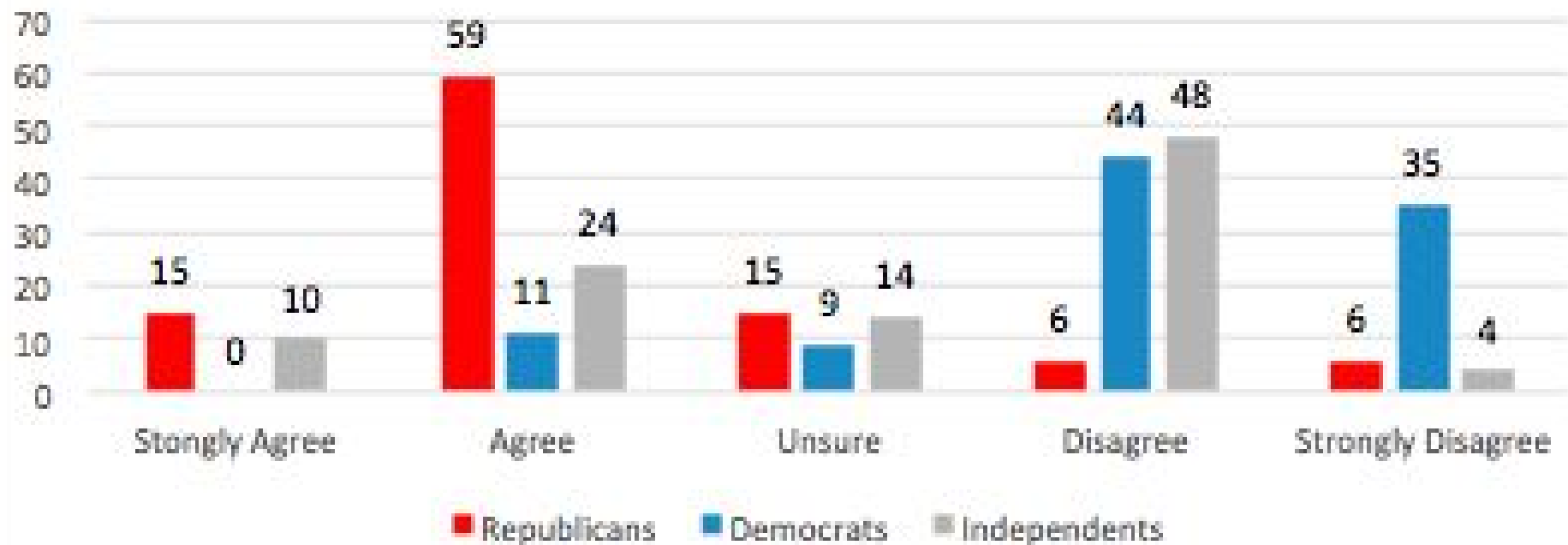


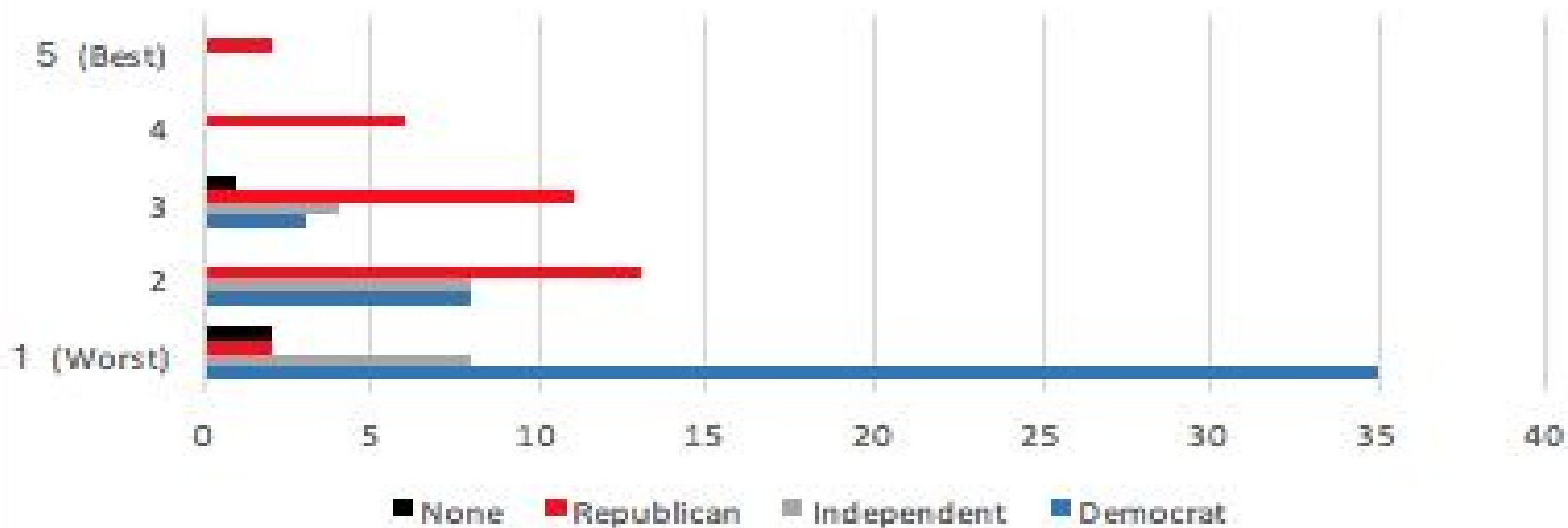
Figure 4: Do you agree with the idea of 'Trumps Mexican Border Wall?'



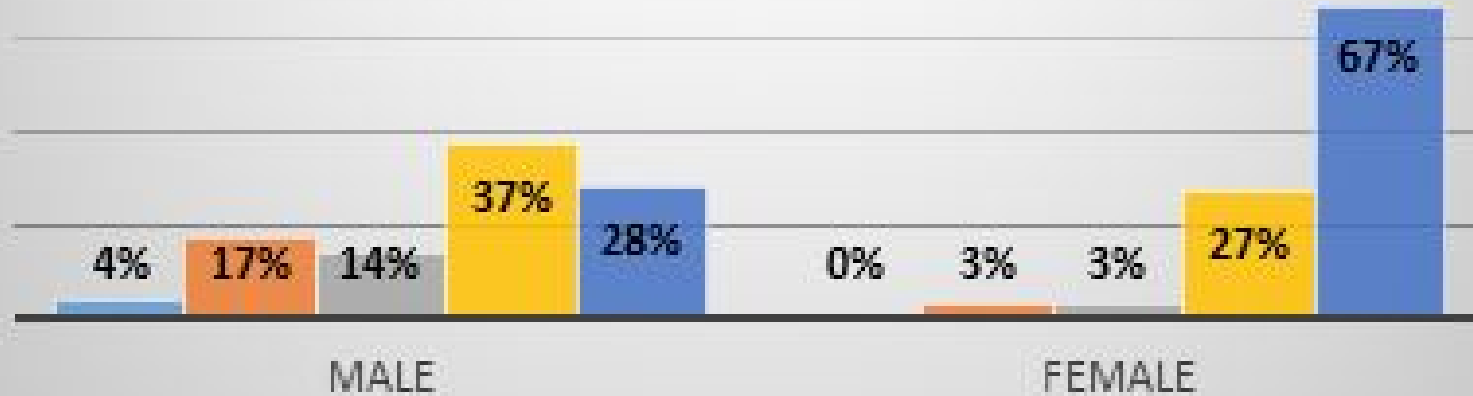
Do you agree there needs to be heavier border enforcement along the US-Mexico border?
